

South Burnett Transport Directory

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OVERVIEW

Graham House Community Centre Murgon, established SBCITS to offer coordinated, planned transport options to people from the South Burnett community who are transport disadvantaged.

This transport directory has been compiled to provide people with information about transport options and subsidies within the South Burnett and to access regional centres.

By sharing information about transport services SBCITS hopes to increase the range of transport options that people have.

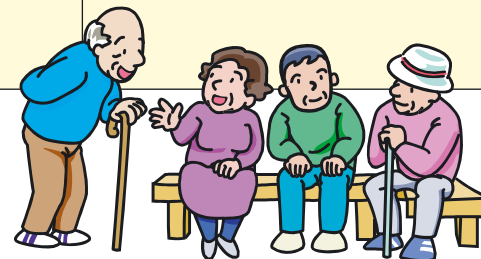

2. HOSPITALS AND MEDICAL FACILITIES

Some tips that might help before you make your next medical appointment:

- Think about how you will get there?
- Ask if a clinic for your medical need is offered closer to home?
- Is there a time when a friend or a relative may be more able to take you? Ask for an appointment to fit within this time.
- Does the specialist you need to see have a private practice closer to home?

The Amount you will need to pay above the Medicare refund may be less than the travel costs to the public medical service provider.

- Ask your local doctor if he/she can do any follow up needed.
- The “Health Information Line” may be able to help in locating specialist clinics closest to home or closer to transport.
